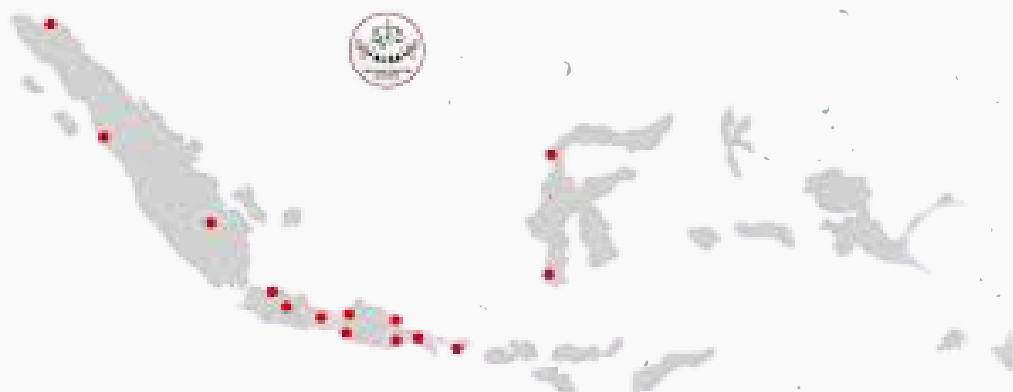
ABOUT ALSA




ABOUT ALSA LOCAL CHAPTER BRAWIJAYA

Speech is a competition that aims to improve skills in public speaking and also thinking critically also expressing an opinion or idea in the form of prepared speech that will be delivered in front of the judges.

3. STORY TELLING (Highschool)

Story Telling is a competition that aims to improve creativity among high school students which the participant will tell a story in english and use any kind of supplies to support the role they perform. The ALSA E – Cont 2020 participant will bring story related to the cry of nature

Legal Opinion is a competition focusing on improving the participant legal knowledge and legal skills, the participant will give an opinion about legal issues that will be given by ALSA E – Cont 2020. The opinion will be based on legal documents and legal regulations that support the statements.
